Who is Eligible?

- Confirmed attendance in a business program with major field of specialization in accounting, economics, finance, business management, business technology, information technology, marketing, operations management, human resources management, international business, or entrepreneurship at an accredited university for the Fall 2025 semester
- Excellent Academic Achievement
- Experience in local or student clubs/organizations, especially those involved with helping others learn
- Volunteer leadership achievements
- Knowledge of Zonta International and its programs

Application Requirements

- Completion of the official application
- Verification of current enrollment by school official.
- Two confidential recommendations from adults, not related to the applicant, such as teachers, school officials or community leaders.
